- **PTC Course Report - MMI November 2010**

2 DAY PTC COURSE Memon Medical Institute (MMI) 27th & 28th November 2010



MMI Building

A two day **PTC** provider course was conducted at Memon Medical Institute (MMI), Karachi on 27th and 28th November 2010. MMI is a 332 bedded tertiary care upcoming hospital in the suburbs of Karachi city, approximately 5 km from Quid-e-Azam International Airport. It is strategically a potential site for trauma patients as two major highways travel on its two sides within a distance of 15 to 20 kms.

A pre-course meeting was held with **PTC** Sindh faculty and it was decided that China experience will be used to improve the **PTC** provider course as three of the local faculty members were also part of the **PTC** China Faculty. It was also concluded that at least half of the instructors should be those who are not experienced as **PTC** instructors and they should run the course sessions under direct supervision by experienced **PTC** faculty.



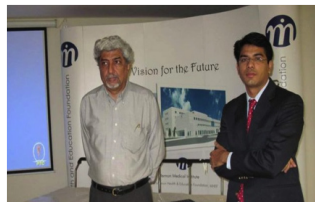
Therefore, following instructors were selected for the course at MMI:

The Trustees and Directors of MMI visited the course and appreciated the efforts of **PTC** faculty.



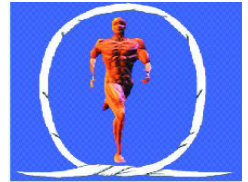
