What was good about the course?

- 1. This was the third PTC 2 Day Course to be held outside of Honiara.
- 2. Half of the participants were from the rural clinics and the other half were from Buala Hospital. when the coursec was conducted there was no doctor at Buala hospital for the past 2 months.
- 3. "It was my first time to attend this, very interesting. I have learnt very important ways to tackle emergencies. Now iwould not panic especially of the ABCD of trauma/Primary Survey" Qoute from a participant.
- 4. 9 of the participants indicated that the best part of the 2 day course were the scenarios, while 7 indicated skills stations.

What could be improved? Recommendations for future course?

- 1. All of participants were Registered Nurses, the selection of participants wered one by the local couterpart at Buala Hospital-Melody Siapu. Working with a local counter part especially in a scattered islands like in here in Solomon Islands is highly recommended, they know their province better.
- 2. 80% of participants indicated time was too short, 2 days is not enough, most suggested 3-5 days so that they can grasp the principles more better.
- 3. Instructors Gabriel and patrick were first time PTC Instructors after doing the Instructors course in 2008 in Honiara, they did exceptionally well in lecturing and running the skill stationa and scenarios, this is because they were preparing well prior to the course days and they ask questions as how best they can transfer the knowledge. These 2 are also trainees currently attached with the surgical department at NRH, they were able to share and express with simplicity the principles of PTC.
- 4. Local langauge especially Solomon pidgin was used by all instructors, emphasizing on the practical aspect of the principles applicable to the local setting.




