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Executive Summary

Following the PTC (Myanmar) inauguration programme in Mandalay in March 2010, the local PTC (Yangon Team) conducted 2 workshops in Yangon in June 12~13 and 14~15, 2010. On this occasion, the local team were fully responsible for the planning and execution of the programme. Dr James Kong attended and assisted during the training days.

During this trip, Dr James Kong also participated in a planning development meeting at the MMA with Professor Myint Thaug (Hon Secretary MMA), the local PTC(MM) Program Coordinator. The activities to date were reviewed and the next steps actions discussed. On his return to HK, he also held meeting with Dr TW Lee to fine tune the plans. The following program has been circulated in a draft format and is now recommended for the coming year.

Activities to date & Current Resources

1. March 2009 Programme Inauguration Yangon
2. March 2010 Programme Inauguration Mandalay
3. Local Instructors trained 30 (Yangon); 15 (Mandalay) -(? 50% attrition, mainly due to transfer to work in the outlying community district environment.)

Planning assumptions...

- MMA has started to establish a PTC -Special Interest Group opened to all trained instructors.
- Regular refresher training for all instructors including medical education & quality media presentations.
- Dedicated Program Coordinator and assistant for Yangon and Mandalay from the senior members of the group.
- PTC (MM) to establish 'regular' teams to run the courses (Team 1, Team 2, Team 3, etc..) all year around.
- Each course to be led by a 'team' with Course in charge and a maximum of up to 6 instructors.
- 2 Provider Courses per program with 20 candidates in each course
- Overseas facilitators to supervise each program for the coming 2 years (2010 - 2012)
- Overseas facilitators to conduct ONE Instructor Course annually.

- Weakness in

 - year plan
 - regular auditing with data base analysis
 - regular meeting and discussion among instructors
 - more local courses minimal 3 – 4 times a year
 - maintenance and collection of teaching aids
 - measure the real benefits of practicing doctors (hospital based assessments)
 - pre-hospital care system development
 - emergency medical care service in any crisis
