

## **Executive Summary for PTC HQ**

### **Aim:**

This is the first PTC done under the banner of PTC (TSN). The aim was to train young surgical postgraduates in a medical college with a vision to incorporate the same in the course curriculum.

### **Methodology:**

The first course was done in August 2013 where 4 instructors were made. This faculty were professors in the department of surgery, JNM College. This was done to facilitate the next course done on 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> October, 2013.

### **Course Descriptions:**

- A) **Course overview:** The course overview was done a day earlier on the 7<sup>th</sup> October where the Vice Chancellor of the University, Mr. Brig Z. Shah, the Director of AIIMS Dr. MC Misra, the head of departments of PGI, Chandigarh, Prof. Yadav and head SGIPGI Lucknow Prof. Dham attended.
  
- B) A two day Primary Trauma Care (PTC) course was run at Aligarh Medical College, Aligarh, Uttar Pradesh on 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> of October 2013. There were 22 participants from different colleges i.e. J.N. Medical College, AMU, Aligarh, GSVM Medical College, Kanpur and Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad that attended the course. The course was well supported by the Administration department & Medical College staffs. Organisation was good, the teaching facilities were adequate, and the snacks were excellent.

The two days course was started at 9AM morning on 8<sup>th</sup> Oct. with an introduction about course. The standard two days PTC course plan was followed without variations. Various procedures of ICTD, Cricothyroidotomy and tracheostomy were practised on animal carcass.

The course was well received. Evaluation was completed. All aspects of the course were rated as good or above by participants. Comments were generally positive – would like more time, should do this course for other staff.
